

Rising costs threaten the completion of the Haddenham Development

Dear friend,

To those of you that were fortunate enough to camp this year, we hope you had a wonderful time after so many years of no camps, getting back to nature, making new friends, and creating new memories. To those that didn't, we hope you are able to join us soon.

As I'm sure you have heard by now, we are in the middle of a large scale project to rebuild our headquarters at Haddenham.

This is where we train new staff and where we keep and maintain all our equipment including the tents, axes and kitchen tools that help us build a home in the field. It is thanks to the work done every month by our volunteers at Haddenham, that we are able to send over 1200 children camping each year, and thanks to them that we were able to return to the field to begin making memories again this year.

A few years ago, despite our best efforts to maintain the buildings, we had to face the fact that they were no longer usable, with many of them being condemned. We had to decide whether to rebuild, or move location entirely. We decided to stay put, preserving our history, and after demolishing the existing main building, construction has begun!

You may have noticed that we ran a considerably reduced programme of camps this year, and this is due to us having to move all the equipment into temporary storage containers, making it impossible to run as many camps as we would have liked.

Thanks to all the generous donations we've received so far, and the volunteers who keep FSC running, we're excited to say we are making fantastic progress. Foundations have been dug, and the walls and roof were added at the beginning of the summer but we still need to add doors, floors and all fittings, before the building can become fully operational.



In 1978, we bought the land and our volunteers converted the buildings into spaces we could use to store and repair our equipment. 40 years later these buildings were no longer usable and had been condemned.



Amazing progress is being made every day to get the new building built in time.

We absolutely must find the funds in order to complete the project, so we can get back to sending as many children on camp as possible. We have excellent momentum, and with your support we can keep this going.

This building is the future of FSC, and is the key to us being able to run a full programme of camps again. We have the majority of the funds in place, but we need this final push now to get us over the line, and give us a usable building for 2023.
